Subject:	SB 900-A – Relating to organized retail theft Work Session Recommendations
SB 900-A establishes the Organized Retail Theft Grant Program designed to assist cities, counties, community-based organizations, and the Oregon State Police, with costs incurred in addressing and prosecuting organized retail theft. The measure includes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$5 million to the Criminal Justice Commission for the purposes of providing competitive grants for this purpose. The measure is effective January 1, 2024.	
The Commission anticipates needing a limited duration position to administer the grant program at an estimated cost of \$186,598, which would leave approximately \$4,813,402 available for grants.
