Subject: HB 2087 – Relating to forest products harvest taxation

Work Session Recommendations

HB 2087 is the Harvest Tax bill. The measure extends three components of the harvest tax for two years that would otherwise expire at the end the 2023 calendar year. These components fund a portion of the activities of the OSU Forest Research Laboratory, up to 40% of the administration of the Forest Practices Act by the Oregon Department of Forestry, and professional forestry education at OSU.

The recommended amendment adjusts the rate in ORS 321.015(3); changing the rate per thousand board feet from 207.02 cents to 253.46 cents. The changed rate is required to support up to 40% of the budgeted expenditures for administration of the Forest Practices Act based on projected harvest volumes as of 3/31/23

Recommended Changes
