Subject: SB 546 – Relating to chemicals used in cosmetic products.

Work Session Recommendations

SB 546 requires the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to establish by rule a list of highpriority chemicals of concern used in cosmetic products. OHA is directed to post this list on their website and review and, if appropriate, revise the list every three years.

Manufacturers selling or distributing cosmetics with more than trace amounts of the highpriority chemicals on OHA's list must post a notice on their website to Oregon residents. Additionally, the measure prohibits manufacturers from distributing or selling cosmetics with chemicals prescribed in the measure. OHA may impose civil penalties on manufacturers who fail to adhere to these requirements.
