Subject: SB 1050 – Relating to the implementation of new academic content

Work Session Recommendations

Legislation requiring the State Board of Education to establish content standards for ethnic studies and Holocaust and genocide studies was enacted in 2019. Senate Bill 1050 aligns the implementation date for both sets of standards and adds a requirement for ODE to provide professional development related to Holocaust and genocide studies to the existing requirement for professional development related to ethnic studies.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -1 amendment, which appropriates a total of \$2,767,466 General Fund to the Department of Education to implement provisions of the bill. \$187,719 covers the position costs of 1 new position (0.88 FTE) to administer the grant program that will fund training grants for teachers. \$329,747 addresses the costs of an advisory panel, an instructional materials panel, and professional services; and \$2,250,000 funds the grant program for teacher training.
