Subject:SB 1041 - Relating to health insurance coverage of breast examinationsWork Session Recommendations

SB 1041 prohibits group health benefit plans and individual health benefit plans in Oregon from charging a deductible, coinsurance, copayment or other out of pocket expenses for medically necessary supplemental or diagnostic breast exams. This prohibition does not apply to health savings accounts and applies to all policies or certificates of insurance issued, renewed, or extended after January 1, 2024.

Changing the services included in the list of required services that health benefit plans must cover will impact the premiums for the employee health plans offered by the Public Employees' Benefit Board (PEBB) and the Oregon Educators Benefit Board (OEBB) - both of which are in the budget for the Oregon Health Authority.

PEBB and OEBB actuaries estimate that premiums for their plans could increase by an average of 0.9% under the measure. For PEBB, this increase could result in an additional cost of \$862,793 and OEBB's premiums could increase by \$582,469 in the 2023-25 biennium. Both PEBB and OEBB operate with Other Funds budgets of \$2.5 billion and nearly \$2 billion, respectively, and have sufficient Other Funds limitation to initially absorb any potential cost of this bill until more information is available on actual realized costs and whether additional limitation is required.

Final Subcommittee Action

LFO recommends that SB 1041 be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
