RE: Legislative Review of Executive Appointments



RESIDENTIAL OMBUDSMAN AND PUBLIC GUARDIANSHIP ADVISORY BOARD

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Residential Ombudsman and Public Guardianship Advisory Board subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Statutory Requirements³

The board consists of 11 members, seven of whom are appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate.⁴ Members of the board must be residents of this state and may not have a financial or fiduciary interest in residential facilities, long term care facilities, or service providers, or involvement in the licensing or certification of residential facilities, long term care facilities, or service providers. Members serve four-year terms.

Membership must include:

- Seven members who are appointed by the Governor (ALLEN, GLAUS, HINES, KAO, ST. JOHN, WILLIAMS, VACANT).
- One member who is appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives (JANSSEN).
- One member who is appointed by the President of the Senate (STOCK).
- One member who is appointed by the House Minority Leader (TERRY).
- One member who is appointed by the Senate Minority Leader (MOWRY).

One member is appointed by the Governor from each list of four names submitted by organizations for seniors, organizations for persons with mental illness, and the Oregon Council on Developmental Disabilities. Of the four remaining members, two of whom must have expertise in the provision of guardianship, conservatorship and other fiduciary services for persons with inadequate resources.

The board must select one of its members as chairperson and another as vice chairperson, for such terms and with duties and powers necessary for the performance of the functions of such offices as the board determines. The board must meet at least once each month and confer each month with the Long Term Care Ombudsman.

Duties and Authority

The Long-Term Care Ombudsman program serves long-term care facility residents through complaint investigation, resolution, and advocacy for improvement in resident care.⁵ The board monitors the program and advises policymakers on related issues.

The board must:6

- monitor the Long-Term Care Ombudsman program;
- advise the Governor and the Legislative Assembly on the Long-Term Care Ombudsman program; and
- nominate, after interviews and according to prescribed criteria, three persons to fill the Long-Term Care Ombudsman position or to fill a vacancy in the position.

The board may review any action by the ombudsman appealable to the board and, if the board disagrees with the action of the ombudsman, refer the resolution back with instructions.⁷
