QUALITY EDUCATION COMMISSION

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Quality Education Commission subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Statutory Requirements³

The commission consists of 11 members appointed by the Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate (HENRY, HEPPER, PREUS, **REXFORD**, SEQUEIRA, SCOTT-SCHWALBACH, SWANDER).⁴ No more than five members of the commission may be employed by a school district at the time of appointment (COX, MOONEY, TOWNSEND, DANZUKA). Members serve four-year terms, at the pleasure of the Governor, and are eligible for reappointment.

The Governor must select one of the members of the commission as chairperson and another as vice chairperson, for such terms and with duties and powers necessary for the performance of the functions of those offices as the Governor determines.⁵ A majority of the members of the commission constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business. The commission meets at the call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the commission.

Duties and Authority

The Oregon Educational Act for the 21st Century established quality education goals for the state's K-12 public schools.⁶ The commission determines the amount of funding needed to meet those goals.⁷ The commission must:⁸

- each biennium, determine the amount of moneys sufficient to ensure that the state's system of K-12 public education meets the quality goals;
- identify best practices based on research, data, professional judgment, and public values that lead to high student performance and the costs of implementing those best practices in the state's K-12 public schools; and
- each biennium, issue a report to the Governor and the Legislative Assembly that
 identifies: current practices in the state's system of K-12 public education, the
 costs of continuing those practices, and the expected student performance under
 those practices; and the best practices for meeting the quality goals, the costs of
 implementing the best practices, and the expected student performance under
 the best practices; and at least two alternatives for meeting the quality goals.
