Subject: HB 2468 A – Relating to Child Care
Work Session Recommendations

The measure directs the Early Learning Council (ELC) to adopt rules to establish reasonable requirements for landlords of tenants who operate family childcare homes and prohibits ELC from considering provider's children who are between the ages of 10 and 12 when establishing capacity limits under certain circumstances. In addition, the measure modifies the amount of supplemental payment made to providers.

The -A5 amendment appropriates \$7,782 General Fund to OHA and \$304,611 General Fund to DHS for the purposes of the measure. In addition, the measure provides \$203,550 Other Funds limitation to OHA, \$389,847 Other Funds limitation to DHS, and \$59,593 Federal Funds limitation to DHS for the purposes of the measure.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends the adoption of the -A5 amendment.
