SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 582 Relating to Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Training Program

Senate Bill 582 requires state agencies in Oregon that authorize or fund the installation of electric vehicle charging systems to ensure installation contractors possess all necessary licenses and have at least one electrician with an Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Training Program certification supervising or participating in the installation.

The Department of Consumer and Business Services Electrical and Elevator Board is to approve the Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Training Program, and review equivalent training programs for consideration, as a continuing education program. The Board is to review certain data annually and may audit the curriculum.

The -A4 amendment removes a grant program for individuals who successfully complete an Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Training Program.

The measure takes effect January 1, 2024, with an anticipated minimal fiscal impact.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends SB 582 be amended by the –A4 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
