

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 2048

Relating to behavior analysis interventionists

HB 2048 directs the Health Licensing Office within the Oregon Health Authority to issue provisional registration to applicants for behavior analysis interventionists. This includes the adoption of rules to establish a process for issuing provisional registration and clarifies timelines under which provisional registration must be issued.

The -A5 amendment removes the requirement for the Health Licensing Office to contract with a third party to study access to behavior analysis interventionists, and this removal results in a minimal fiscal impact for the bill.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 2048 be amended by the -A5 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
