SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 2665 Relating to temporary staffing agencies

To: Ways and Means Full Committee From: Human Services Subcommittee

Carrier: Senator Campos

HB 2665 requires the Health Licensing Office within the Oregon Health Authority to establish a process to receive and investigate complaints regarding temporary staffing agencies, requires temporary staffing agencies to ensure personnel meet certain requirements, and directs OHA to establish maximum rates that temporary staffing agencies may charge. The bill also directs OHA to establish a process for granting an emergency waiver from the maximum rates.

The -A4 amendment funds 6 positions (5.28 FTE) to coordinate rate setting, conduct required reporting, and investigate complaints.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 2665 be amended by the -A4 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
