Subject:	HB 2054 – Relating to the status of district attorneys in the Public Employees Retirement System Work Session Recommendations

The measure specifies that deputy district attorneys qualify as police officers under the Public Employees Retirement System. This measure is effective on January 1, 2024; however, eligibly provisions apply on or after the effective date.

A preliminary staff measure summary, fiscal impact statement, and revenue impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). There is a budget amendment on OLIS that removes district attorneys and clarified the Police and Fire service eligibility of deputy district attorneys.
