Subject: SB 1002 – Relating to school facilities

Work Session Recommendations

SB 1002A eliminates the distributions "carved out" from the State School Fund for facility grants, and creates a new "carve out" to be used by the Department of Education (ODE) to support school districts, education service districts (ESDs), and public charter schools to respond to threats or hazards and to improve the safety and security of school students and staff. This measure eliminates a little-used program and allows the Department to continue the School Safety and Emergency Management program begun with a federal grant that expires during the 2023-25 biennium.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the –A2 amendment, which provides \$3.0 million Other Funds expenditure limitation to ODE for contract dollars and for two positions (1.88 FTE) to manage the program. Contract funds would be provided to ESDs for school emergency management consulting services.
