**Subject:** HB 2574 – Relating to post-exposure prophylaxes

**Work Session Recommendations** 

HB 2574 requires hospitals to adopt policies and procedures to dispense a five-day supply of human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) post-exposure prophylactic (PEP) drugs or therapies following an individual's exposure to HIV.

The Oregon Health Authority is directed to provide to each Type A or Type B hospital in Oregon with a 30-day supply of HIV PEP drugs or therapies once each calendar year. Hospitals are not obligated to accept this supply. Type A hospitals have 50 or fewer beds and are located 30 miles or more from another acute inpatient care facility. Type B hospitals have 50 or fewer beds and are 30 miles or less from another acute inpatient care facility.

## **Recommended Changes**

Upon further consideration, OHA determined existing systems could be used to pay for HIV PEP drugs and OHA would request the manufacturer deliver the drugs directly to the hospital negating the need for an inventory management system and a position to create and maintain the system. Additionally, there is a modest adjustment to the projected costs for HIV PEP drugs.

LFO recommends adoption of the –A8 amendment. The - A8 amendment includes \$259,052 General Fund. Costs include \$166,028 General Fund to provide 33 Type A and Type B hospitals with a 30-day supply of HIV PEP drugs. An additional \$93,024 General Fund is included to repurpose two existing positions to oversee, evaluate, and coordinate access to HIV PEP drugs.

MOTION: I move adoption of the –A8 amendment to HB 2574. (VOTE)

## **Final Subcommittee Action**

LFO recommends that HB 2574 as amended by the –A8 amendment, be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
