Subject: SB 606 – Relating to compensation for nonprofit organizations that provide services on behalf of the state
Work Session Recommendations

SB 606 creates the 15-member Task Force on Modernizing Grant Funding and Contracting, which is to examine how the state's granting and public procurement practices limit the wages of employees of nonprofit organizations. The task force is to submit a report to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to grantmaking and public procurement no later than September 15, 2024. The bill directs the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to provide staff support for the task force, and the task force sunsets on December 31, 2024.

The - A6 amendment removes section 1 of the measure, which made changes to compensation practices for certain state agencies. The amendment also adds \$181,355 Other Funds expenditure limitation for DAS to hire one limited-duration, full time Operations and Policy Analyst 4 position to staff the task force.

Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the –A6 amendment.
