Subject: $\quad$ SB 1049 - Relating to state financial administration Work Session Recommendations

SB 1049 relates to state financial administration. The -2 amendment replaces the bill. The amended version is referred to as the "Program Change" bill. The measure has an emergency clause and is effective upon passage.

The measure, as amended, implements the statutory changes necessary to support the 2023-25 legislatively adopted budget and to clarify the application of statutes. The bill is not an appropriation bill and therefore does not include the appropriation of funds.

The fiscal or budgetary impacts of provisions of this measure are contained in SB 5506 (budget reconciliation), HB 5005 (bond authorization), in agency budget measures, or policy measures for the 2023-25 biennium.
