Allows laws that require disclosure of contributions and expenditures made to influence an election. Allows laws that require campaign or election advertisements to identify who paid for them. Campaign contribution limits cannot prevent effective advocacy. Applies to laws enacted or approved on or after January 1, 2016.</p> <p>Result of "No" Vote: "No" vote retains current law. Courts currently find the Oregon Constitution does not allow laws limiting campaign expenditures. Approves other provisions.</p> <p>Result of "No" Vote: "No" vote retains current law. Cigarettes are taxed at current rate of \$1.33 per pack. Tax on cigars is capped at 50 cents per cigar.
