HB 2925 Continues Advancing Health Equity

HB 2925 offers technical and timeline fixes to HB 4052 (2022) so the OACO and community members can develop and advocate for policy recommendations made by the affinity group task forces to improve social and health disparities in Oregon.



HB 2925:

- **Task Forces recommend their work continue**
- **Fixes gap in staffing between 6/30/22 and report deadline of 11/1/22**
- **No budget difference, just duration extension**
- **Aligns timeline for Task Forces to develop legislative concepts and partner in accountability, advocacy, and implementation**

HB 2925 allows the affinity group task forces to stay involved in developing their recommendations through the 2023-2025 biennium and funds three OACO staff to support the task force's work.



HB 2925 invests in community-driven solutions for Key Priority Areas including: K-12 education, housing and homelessness, and health and behavioral health care.
