What the bill does:

- Changes Oregon's Fish & Wildlife Commission structure from congressional districts to a place-based model used by OWRD.
- The bill also requires Commissioners to understand the relationships tribes have with the land, water, and wildlife the Commission oversees.
- In choosing Commissioners, the Governor will have to consider racial, ethnic, gender, and geographic diversity.
