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## SUMMARY

Prohibits disclosure of individually identifiable data collected in accordance with uniform standards adopted by Oregon Health Authority for collection of data on race, ethnicity, preferred spoken and written languages, disability status, sexual orientation and gender identity.

Exempts from prohibition on public body's inquiring into or collecting information about individual's country of birth such data collected by authority or Department of Human Services in accordance with uniform standards adopted by authority for collection of data on race, ethnicity, preferred spoken and written languages, disability status, sexual orientation and gender identity.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## **OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT**

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure prohibits the public disclosure of individually identifiable data collected by the Oregon Health Authority and the Department of Human Services in surveys and by the authority and the department's respective programs regarding race, ethnicity, preferred spoken and written languages, disability status, sexual orientation and gender identity.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could gain individually identifiable data collected by the authority and the department regarding individuals' race, ethnicity, preferred spoken and written languages, disability status, sexual orientation and gender identity.
