SUMMARY

Directs Oregon Health Authority to require psilocybin service centers and psilocybin service facilitators licensed by authority to collect and report specified data. Requires authority to collect and compile specified data and provide data to Oregon Health and Science University.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure personally identifiable information of clients served by and individuals denied service at psilocybin service centers.

If the public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public might be able to receive demographic data on clients served by and individuals denied service at psilocybin service centers.
