SUMMARY

Enacts interstate Nurse Licensure Compact. Permits Oregon State Board of Nursing to disclose specified information to Interstate Commission of Nurse Licensure Compact Administrators. Exempts individuals authorized to work as nurses under multistate licensure privilege from requirement to obtain license from board and from restrictions on use of titles. Allows board to use moneys to meet financial obligations imposed on State of Oregon as result of participation in compact.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure allows Nurse Licensure Compact member states contributing information to the coordinated licensure information system to designate information that may not be shared with the public without the express permission of the contributing state. The measure also prohibits the public disclosure of personally identifiable information obtained from the coordinated licensure information system except to the extent permitted by the laws of the state contributing the information.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive information from the coordinated licensure information system that is designated as confidential or exempt from public disclosure by the contributing state.
