Measure Description:

Prohibits manufacturer from selling or offering to sell cosmetic developed through use of cosmetic animal test.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Justice, Judicial Department

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transferring the measure from the House Committee on Business and Labor to the House Committee on Judiciary.

The measure prohibits a manufacturer from selling or offering to sell specific cosmetics that are developed or manufactured on, or after January 1, 2024, that use cosmetic animal tests. The Attorney General may execute an investigation if it appears that a manufacturer has possession, custody, or control of any information, documents, or other material that could be in violation of the measure. In addition, the Attorney General may impose a civil penalty of not more than \$5,000 for the first day of violation and not more than \$1,000 for each day following, that the violation continues. Penalties shall be deposited into the Department of Justice Protection and Education Revolving Account.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Judiciary.
