WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Prohibits landlords from denying application for tenancy based on certain rental or financial screening or admissions criteria if applicant is refugee from Ukraine. Waives written test or actual demonstration requirements for issuance of driver license for refugee from Ukraine who holds valid driver license issued by Ukraine that expires on or after January 1, 2022. Sunsets January 2, 2028. Declares emergency, effective on passage.
