**Measure Description:**

Prescribes requirements for information recorded on student transcript, including types of credits earned by student.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

School Districts, Oregon Department of Education, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Community Colleges, Oregon Youth Authority, Department of Corrections

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue to the Senate Committee on Education.

Senate Bill 992 requires every public education provider to record specified information on a student’s transcript, including types of credits earned by the student. The measure establishes requirements for when a student may be enrolled in a course for modified credit. It removes an alternative certificate as an option for completing high school and allows a student to receive a certificate of attendance. The measure takes effect on January 1, 2024 and becomes operate on July 1, 2024.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Education.
