Measure Description:

Permits contracting agency to grant preference to procuring for public use goods that are fabricated or processed, or services that are performed, entirely within this state if goods or services cost not more than five percent more than goods not processed or fabricated, or services not performed, entirely within this state.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services, Cities, Counties, Department of Justice, Department of Transportation, School Districts, Special Districts Association of Oregon, Statewide

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
