Requires State Department of Agriculture to enter into a mutually acceptable agreement with an Indian tribe or related business entity, to enable the department to administer and enforce certain pesticide provisions, before the department issues a pesticide license or certificate to the Indian tribe, business entity of an Indian tribe, or an employee of the Indian tribe or business entity.
