Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Bond Authorization for biennial expenses.

Impact Explanation:

The measure reduces the 21-23 bond authorization for a public university project. Article XI-F(1) general obligation bond authority was reduced by \$20,210,000 to reflect a reduced scope for the Oregon Institute of Technology's new residence hall project. The amounts are reflected as reductions in debt service payments of about \$1.26 million a year, which translates to an increase in General Fund revenue available for other expenditures.
