WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Defines “third-party logistics provider” and updates definition of “wholesale distributor drug outlet” in Oregon Law (ORS 689.005). Becomes operative November 26, 2023. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Consistency of definitions with federal law

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The federal Drug Supply Chain Security Act (DSCSA) includes provisions designed to strengthen the integrity of the pharmaceutical distribution supply chain, including licensure of prescription drug wholesale distributors and third-party logistics providers.

Senate Bill 970 updates Oregon Law (ORS 689.005) so that statutory definitions of "wholesale distributor drug outlet" and "third-party logistics provider" are consistent with federal law.
