Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys to be used for regional health equity coalitions.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure appropriates \$12.0 million General Fund to the Oregon Health authority beginning July 1, 2023, to provide funding for:

- Five additional regional health equity coalitions
- 15 regional health equity coalitions to hire two additional full-time staff
- Requires \$2.2 million of the \$12.0 million be allocated to regional health equity coalitions for:
 - Facility costs
 - Child care/transportation/translation/interpretation services or programs
 - Pay stipends to regional health equity coalition members attending meetings.

The measure declares an emergency and is effective on passage.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
