### SUMMARY

Amends abandonment presumptions for securities and distributions.

Shortens length of time until unpaid wages become presumed unclaimed to one year.

Establishes owners' rights to income or proceeds from unclaimed property held by State Treasurer until sale.

Exempts from disclosure certain records of State Treasurer relating to unclaimed property examinations and claims.

### OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure records held by the State Treasurer relating to unclaimed property examinations and claims.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public might be able to collect personal or business records and information that the State Treasurer collects as part of an examination regarding abandoned property reporting and the personal information of individuals making claims to unclaimed property.
