WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Modifies crime of offensive littering; provides that offensive littering is a Class B violation unless the person intentionally and impermissibly discards refuse of one cubic foot or more, in which case it is a Class C misdemeanor.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Current law and enforcement of the law
- Reducing workload of district attorneys and courts
- Reason for cubic foot as point for escalation of crime

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Currently, pursuant to ORS 164.805, the crime of offensive littering is a Class C misdemeanor, regardless of the volume of refuse a person discards. House Bill 2593 modifies the crime of offensive littering to a Class B violation if the illegally discarded refuse amounts to less than a cubic foot.
