Measure Description:

Permits owner of self-service storage facility to advertise or publish notice of sale of personal property that is subject to lien once in newspaper of general circulation or on publicly accessible website that regularly advertises or offers personal property for auction or sale. Permits sale 10 days after date of advertisement or publication.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services, Cities, State Treasurer, Judicial Department, Counties

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
