Measure Description:

Authorizes Director of Employment Department to study alternative arrangements by which employers may make tax payments required under unemployment insurance law.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Employment Department, Department of Revenue

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Labor and Business to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure authorizes the Director of the Employment Department to study alternative arrangements by which employers may make tax payments required under unemployment insurance law and requires a report to the legislature by December 1, 2023.
