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Measure Description:

Allows the governing body of a county to grant a specially assessed value equal to a destroyed homestead's assessed value for the 2020-2021 property tax year if the homestead was rebuilt by the same owner on the same lot to replace a homestead that was destroyed by September 2020 wildfires. Specifies eligibility for the specially assessed value and the process by which an owner must file a claim.
