Measure Description:

Adds to types of providers eligible for tax credit allowed to rural medical care providers, psychologist, clinical social worker, professional counselor or marriage and family therapist, medical laboratory scientist or medical laboratory technician, naturopathic physician, and pharmacist. Modifies credit requirements for an optometrist. Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2024.
