Measure Description:

Requires Department of Human Services, in consultation with Office of Immigrant and Refugee Advancement, to award contracts to organizations to provide support services to immigrants and refugees.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Judicial Department, Department of Human Services, Department of Justice

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Early Childhood and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Welcome and Reception program within the Office of Immigrant and Refugee Advancement to provide immigrants, refugees, and asylum seekers support services; the measure appropriates an unspecified amount from the General Fund to provide support services.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
