SUMMARY

Prohibits certain persons from disclosing records of sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression of child or ward. Creates exceptions.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure prohibits the Department of Human Services from disclosing records of sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression contained within child welfare records and child abuse reporting records.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public might be able to receive information or records related to sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression of minors contained within child welfare records or child abuse reporting records.
