Measure Description:

Eliminates State School Fund distributions for facility grants.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, School Districts

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure eliminates State School Fund distributions for facility grants. The measure permits the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to expend no more than \$3 million from the State School Fund for expenses incurred by the agency to provide support to school districts before, during, or after a threat or hazard that may affect a school district, and for the purpose of improving student and staff safety and security. This applies to state school fund distributions starting with the 2023-2024 distributions.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
