Measure Description:

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish project connecting adults in custody and former adults in custody to community colleges, public universities, and apprenticeship programs.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bureau of Labor and Industries, Department of Corrections, Counties, Cities, Higher Education Coordinating Commission

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to establish a project that connects adults in custody and former adults in custody to specified community colleges, public universities, and apprenticeship programs. The measure establishes the Oregon Rebound Fund, separate and distinct from the General Fund, credits interest earned back to the fund, and continuously appropriates monies to HECC for establishing the project. The measure declares an emergency and is effective upon passage.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
