Measure Description:

Establishes that perfected and developed water right is not subject to forfeiture if the holder or user of water right used less water on lands to with the right is appurtenant because the holder or user modified irrigation equipment so that the handling facility is capable of handling less than the entire water rate and duty; reduced the rate or duty of water to achieve beneficial use of water on the appurtenant land; and provided information to the Water Resources Department.
