Measure Description:

Specifies that public university governing boards must consist of between 12 and 16 voting members and two nonvoting members. Adds second nonvoting undergraduate student member to public university governing boards. Adds voting graduate student member to certain public university governing boards. Requires public universities to submit annual report to legislative committees relating to higher education detailing the degree of compliance with the measure. Requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to provide meeting opportunities for public university governing board members and opportunities for training in duties and fiduciary responsibilities of public university governing boards.
