WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Appropriates \$205,000 General Fund to State Library of Oregon (SLO) to hire consultant to help libraries apply for federal moneys to provide broadband access. Appropriates \$750,000 General Fund to SLO for deposit in Connecting Oregon Libraries Fund.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Leveraging federal funding
- Libraries' ability to expand broadband access within communities

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The federal <u>E-Rate program</u>, administered by the Federal Communications Commission, helps schools and libraries obtain affordable broadband. The <u>State Library of Oregon</u> (SLO) publishes information about the program, eligibility for participation, and the application process. House Bill 4092 (2022) created the Connecting Oregon Libraries Fund as part of a telecommunications omnibus. Moneys in the fund are appropriated to the State Library of Oregon to match federal dollars received by libraries to provide broadband access.

Senate Bill 885 appropriates \$205,000 from the General Fund to the State Library of Oregon to hire a consultant to help libraries apply for federal moneys to provide broadband access, and appropriates \$750,000 from the General Fund to the Connecting Oregon Libraries Fund to match federal dollars received by libraries to provide broadband access.
