WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs \$29 million from General Fund to industrial lands projects throughout rural Oregon. Directs \$4.5 million to City of Phoenix for transportation and utility improvements of industrial sites. Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Identification of projects that advance economic development throughout all regions of Oregon
- Creating opportunities in rural Oregon for industrial development
- Bipartisan rural economic development package
- Identification of underutilized industrial land
- Benefits for local economy
- Ability of identified projects to leverage different funding streams
- Process for determining which projects, in which communities, were included

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Distributes \$4.5 million to City of Phoenix for transportation and utility improvements of industrial sites.

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 3416 A directs \$29 million from General Fund to economic development projects throughout rural Oregon. Projects scheduled to receive funds include: docks and pilings improvements in City of Depoe Bay; business Incubator development in the City of La Pine; water infrastructure improvements in the City of Monroe; Harney County Infrastructure improvements on industrial land within the City of Burns; infrastructure improvements on industrial land within Baker County; and agricultural industrial infrastructure improvements in the North Unit Irrigation District.
