SUMMARY

Requires psilocybin service center to collect and aggregate specified data and submit aggregated data to Oregon Health Authority. Allows client of psilocybin service center to request psilocybin service center not to submit client's data to authority. Directs authority to submit aggregated data to Oregon Health and Science University.

Requires authority to collect, compile and aggregate specified data and annually make data publicly available.

Becomes operative January 1, 2025.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure personally identifiable information of clients served by and individuals denied service at psilocybin service centers.

If the public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public might be able to receive demographic data on clients served by and individuals denied service at psilocybin service centers.
