Measure Description:

Requires pharmacy benefit managers to annually report to Department of Consumer and Business Services information about certain rebates, fees, price protection payments and other payments received from prescription drug manufacturers.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services, Oregon Health Authority, Board of Pharmacy

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
