**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Appropriates an unspecified amount of General Fund, and increases Other Funds and Federal Funds expenditure limitation by an unspecified amount. Declares an emergency and takes effect July 1, 2023.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Fiscal impact of the measure
- Methods to ensure security of pharmacy lockers and kiosks

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

Ratifies three fees that were administratively approved during the 2022-23 period between legislative sessions, for the Oregon Board of Pharmacy.

**BACKGROUND:**

ORS 291.055(1)(e) stipulates that all new state agency fees or fee increases adopted between the date of adjournment sine die of a regular session of the Legislative Assembly and the date of adjournment sine die of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly, are rescinded upon adjournment sine die of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly unless the fee is authorized by enabling legislation.
