Measure Description:

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Transportation, Division of Motor Vehicles to raise various fees.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Transportation

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Costs related to the measure are indeterminate but anticipated to be minimal at this time - See explanatory analysis.

Analysis: The measure raises various fees for the issuance of identification cards, vehicle inspections, vehicle registration fees for trailers, campers, and motor homes, and the replacement of registration plates. In addition, the measure raises fees for the following most driver license types, driver testing, motorcycle license fees, and reinstatement of revoked driving privileges. The proposed fee increases align more closely with costs of providing various services.

The measure will have a revenue impact on the Oregon Department of Transportation and is anticipated to have a minimal fiscal impact on the Department.
