SUMMARY

Increases fees that may be charged for preparation of court transcripts. Appropriates moneys to carry out provisions increasing fees.

Modifies provisions relating to assignment of senior judges.

Modifies provisions relating to certain judges' authority to authorize execution of search warrant.

Provides that method of service for certain order relating to parenting time is method provided by law for summons.

Corrects incorrect references.

Provides that court filings remain confidential until reviewed and accepted by court.

Modifies provisions relating to contempt.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure prohibits the public disclosure of electronic court records before they are reviewed and accepted by the court.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive electronic records that have been submitted to but not yet reviewed or accepted by the court.
