Measure Description:

Modifies statutory provisions relating to school nutrition, speech-language pathology programs, investigations of sexual conduct or abuse, issuing subpoenas, the role of education service districts in the Student Success Act, and the intensive program for high-needs school districts. Specifies that school district boards and superintendents of school districts participating in the intensive program must accept all recommendations of the student success teams under the intensive program. Specifies that school districts that do not accept the recommendations of a student success team are not eligible for additional funding under the intensive program.
